

## COMMUNITY SOLAR CAPITOL HILL IS HERE!

Just before Thanksgiving, a 25kW solar array atop the Holiday Apartments, a Capitol Hill Housing property at 10<sup>th</sup> and John, began to generate clean renewable electricity. The first community solar project atop affordable housing in the nation, the Capitol Hill Community Solar Project has multiple benefits:

- **CLEAN ENERGY:** it's the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest array on Capitol Hill!
- **LOCAL JOBS:** the system is made in WA and the installer is Seattle-based.
- **SUPPORTS AFFORDABLE HOUSING:** when the project ends in 2020 the installation will belong to Capitol Hill Housing and lower our operating costs for the Holiday Apartments.
